

DIGITAL COGNITIVE ASSESSMENT

Your neurologist has referred you for digital cognitive testing. The results of your test provide your physicians with insight into your cognition and allows them to make appropriate referrals and treatment decisions.

What is it?

- The cognitive assessment is administered in an office setting. A healthcare provider will administer the test and answer any questions you might have.
- The assessment is performed on an iPad with an electronic stylus.
- The assessment consists of 14 mini-tests that assess memory, reasoning, attention, processing, etc. Your responses to the tests are scored and analyzed by your neurologist.
- The entire assessment takes approximately 45 minutes to complete. You will have an opportunity to take short breaks throughout the testing.

How do I get my results?

- Your neurologist will interpret the results of your assessment and discuss them with you at a follow-up appointment or over the phone as appropriate.

What else should I know?

- When your neurologist refers you for testing, you should make appointments for both the testing and follow-up appointment.
- During testing, all of your personal electronic devices must be silenced to avoid any distractions.
- Do not stress about your performance on the assessment. It is important to remain calm and try your best.
